



EDI vs API: both are ways of getting data from one place to another

EDI

Electronic Data Interchange

API

Application Programming Interface

System exchange

Computer to computer exchange of a document in a standard format via FTP



Not real-time

Data transfer has to wait to be sent on file at preset time intervals (snapshot in time approach)



Batch data

Data is sent in batched transactions



One-way communication

Communication is transmitted from sender to receiver



Case-level set up

Case-level coding/testing that takes 60-90 days



Cloud exchange

Standard protocol that allows computer systems to interact via the cloud



Real-time data transfer

Data is transferred immediately but may still take time to work through the rules engine



Transaction data

Data is sent in individual transactions



Bi-directional communication

Communication can be sent and received



Vendor-level set up

Vendor-level integration that allows case-level eligibility to be turned on with no testing required
